### DIN Standards

The welding symbol has an arrow, which points to the location on the drawing where a weld is required. The arrow is attached to a leader line that intersects with a long horizontal reference line. Finally, there's a tail at the opposite end of the reference line that forks off in two directions.

The main feature that distinguishes weld symbol standards is that for ISO 2553 and BS EN 22553, there is an additional feature of a broken reference line. This method is used when a weldment or weld preparation needs to be specified on the 'other side' of the arrow as shown in Fig.19.
