Asterisks denote introduced fishes. The list includes several anadromous species, and two normally marine species (starry flounder and shiner perch) that are occasionally found in freshwater. Only one species (Olympic mudminnow) is a Washington endemic , however three others (Nooksack dace , Salish sucker, and margined sculpin) have very limited distributions outside the state.
