CMS may add coverage of preventive services through the National Coverage Determination (NCD) process if the service meets all of the following criteria: Reasonable and necessary for the prevention or early detection of illness or disability Recommended with a grade of A or B by the United States Preventive Services Task Force (USPSTF)

Medicare Part B (Medical Insurance) covers: One baseline mammogram if you're a woman between ages 35-39. Screening mammograms once every 12 months if you're a woman age 40 or older. Diagnostic mammograms more frequently than once a year, if Medically necessary .

Medicare Part B (Medical Insurance) covers an abdominal aortic screening ultrasound once if you're at risk. You're considered at risk if you have a family history of abdominal aortic aneurysms, or you're a man age 65-75 and have smoked at least 100 cigarettes in your lifetime.

Abdominal aortic aneurysm screening coverage - Medicare

Medicare covers screening colonoscopies once every 24 months if you're at high risk for colorectal cancer. If you aren't at high risk for colorectal cancer, Medicare covers the test once every 120 months, or 48 months after a previous flexible sigmoidoscopy. There's no minimum age requirement. Medicare Part B (Medical Insurance) covers these screenings if your doctor determines you're at risk for diabetes or you're diagnosed with pre-diabetes. You may be eligible for up to 2 screenings each year. These lab tests are covered if you have any of these risk factors: High blood pressure (hypertension)

Medicare Part B (Medical Insurance) covers a "Welcome to Medicare" preventive visit once within the first 12 months you have Part B. Your costs in Original Medicare You pay nothing for the "Welcome to Medicare" preventive visit if your doctor or other qualified health care provider accepts Assignment. The Part B Deductible doesn't apply.

Lung cancer screenings. Medicare Part B (Medical Insurance) covers lung cancer screenings with Low Dose Computed Tomography (LDCT) once each year if you meet all of these conditions: You're age 55-77. You don't have signs or symptoms of lung cancer (asymptomatic). You're either a current smoker or have quit smoking within the last 15 years.

Use of mammograms in routine screening of: (1) asymptomatic women aged 50 and over, and (2) asymptomatic women aged 40 or over whose mothers or sisters have had the disease, is considered medically appropriate, but would not be covered for Medicare purposes.

National Coverage Determination (NCD) for Mammograms (220.4)

Medicare pays for an annual mammogram screening for beneficiaries ages 40 and up. Medicare covers necessary diagnostic mammograms and other types of testing. Part B covers mammograms at a doctor's office, outpatient imaging center, or other outpatient facilities. Costs will be different for screening mammograms than for diagnostic mammograms.

Medicare Coverage of Routine Screening for Thyroid ...

At least 90 percent of all Medicare beneficiaries are currently eligible for thyroid stimulating hormone (TSH) testing under current coverage due to the high prevalence of a wide range of symptoms and conditions that are compatible with common manifestations of thyroid dysfunction but are not specific for such dysfunction.

Medicare waives the coinsurance or copayment and Medicare Part B deductible for a screening Pap test, pelvic examination, and HPV screening if the service meets all coverage conditions.

Screening Pap Tests and Pelvic Examinations - CMS

Within 12 months after enrolling in Medicare, you can see your doctor for a "Welcome to Medicare" visit. If your doctor orders an EKG at that time, Part B will cover it as a preventive screening. This is the only time Medicare will cover a routine screening EKG.

Medicare covers an initial preventive physical exam for all new Medicare beneficiaries. It must be done within one year of enrolling in Medicare. The "Welcome to Medicare" physical includes referrals for preventive services already covered under Medicare, including colorectal cancer screening tests.

Insurance Coverage for Colorectal Cancer Screening
